

## Erin O'Donnell

Erin O'Donnell is the Managing Deputy Commissioner of Chicago Midway International Airport. In this position, she is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the airport including finance and administration, airside and landside operations, vehicle services, and community relations. Ms. O'Donnell oversees a \$185 million operating budget.

Ms. O'Donnell has been employed with the City of Chicago Department of Aviation since 1986. During her tenure, she has held positions in airfield operations, finance and administration divisions at Midway, as well as Senior Airport Properties Manager at O'Hare International Airport. In 1997, Ms. O'Donnell was appointed Deputy Commissioner of Midway. In 2004, she was promoted to Managing Deputy Commissioner of Midway.

During her tenure, Ms. O'Donnell has managed two major initiatives at Midway: the Long-Term Lease of Midway and the Midway Terminal Development Program.

Ms. O'Donnell is a member of the Board of Directors Policy Review Committee for the American Association of Airport Executives. As a life-long resident of the southwest side of Chicago, she volunteers with many organizations including March of Dimes, American Cancer Society and St. Vincent de Paul. She has a B.S. in Accounting and a Masters in Business Administration.

In March 2000, Women's Transportation Seminar honored Ms. O'Donnell as its 2000 Woman of the Year. In November 2000, *Crain's Chicago Business* recognized her as one of its "40 under 40" Chicago Business Leaders. In April 2003, she received the March of Dimes Transportation Person of the Year award.
